### Good Stuff to Know Before You Sign Up

In 2023, IAGI held virtual competitions for GeoGames, sponsored by AGRU and we will be doing that for the 2024 competition. Each team will be asked to build a geomembrane layout (see Team Instructions) using extrusion and wedge welding, proper seam testing techniques etc. The competition will be videotaped. Points are given for both quality and speed of installation . Proctors will oversee the entire process. The results of the competition will be shown and announced during the GeoGames event in Toronto, Canada on 29 April 2024. The winner of this event will take home a trophy and bragging rights.

There in no fee to participate in the GeoGames but you must be a member in good standing of IAGI as of 1 March 2024.

You must hold a CWT that is current as of 1 January 2024 and that does not expire until after 1 May 2024.


