You are asked to wear a company team shirt that includes your company's name / logo. Please wear proper safety equipment during competition. IAGI wants to demonstrate that IAGI members take safety seriously—even when we get together for a good time.

Put your company's best foot forward and let your CWTs shine on the GeoGames battlefield!

Good Stuff to Know Before You Sign Up

In 2023 and in 2024, IAGI held virtual competitions for GeoGames, sponsored by AGRU and we will be doing that for the 2026 competition. Each team will be asked to build a geomembrane layout (see Team Instructions) using extrusion and wedge welding, proper seam testing techniques etc. The competition will be videotaped. Points are given for both quality and speed of installation. Proctors will oversee the entire process. The results of the competition will be shown and announced during the GeoGames event in Montreal, Canada on 14 September 2026. The winner of this event will take home a trophy and bragging rights.

There is no fee to participate in the GeoGames but you must be a member in good standing of IAGI as of 1 March 2026.

You must hold a CWT that is current as of 1 March 2026 and that does not expire until after 1 June 2026.



Turn in the application no later than 1 March 2026. Claim your place in this competition and register today!

1. *Be professional and make it fun! (Cheering sections located outside the testing area are welcome)*
2. *Encourage your welding technicians to wear company apparel such as shirts / safety vests / hard hats with your company logo on them. It is okay to make this entry a shameless plug for your company. After all, that is why we are doing this — for recognition!*

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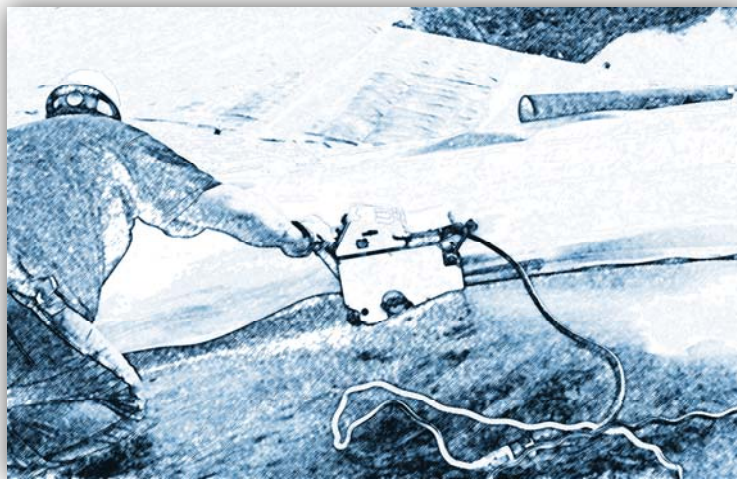
